

Why a Mobility Study?

- To develop alternatives to the current traffic configuration and flows
- To improve access and safety for bicyclists, pedestrians, drivers, transit users
 - To expand recreational use of the waterfront area and boating access
 - To foster additional economic activity in the downtown

What will be done?

- Collect data on existing conditions (traffic counts, signals, infrastructure, etc.)
 - Get feedback from public, City staff, CTDOT
 - Develop possible alternatives for implementation

Route 2, Route 82, Route 32, and Route 12; Chelsea Harbor

When is the study being done?

- Summer 2023-Summer 2024




